This memorandum refers to opening the oversea global center, which is expected to facilitate the practice of the above mentioned agreement and activate an academic exchange in future. Hereby we agree:

- 1. Each global center is set up in both parties' campus with the purpose as follows:
 - -The Center will function as the center of the information source, to collect/compile information to be utilized for both parties' benefits.
 - -The Center will assist students who intend to study abroad according to the student exchange program.
- The name of the university is indicated at the entrance of the Global Center.
- 3. If any expense should occur to run such a Global Center, the matter concerning the running cost and other expenses will be consulted on both parties.
- 4. This agreement will come into force on the date of its signature by both parties and will be valid one year. This agreement will be renewed automatically for further one year when neither disagreement nor abrogation is informed in advance from either party. The alteration or the cancellation of the agreement will be subject to the consultation of both parties.
- Both parties understand that further arrangements will have to be negotiated.
