[Basic Philosophy]

[Basic Policies]

- 2. The faculty will break fresh ground in food, agricultural and environmental sciences, promote research of the environment, and contribute to the reduction of environmental load and the realization of the recycling-oriented society.
- 3. We will promote the preservation of the environment and the realization of sustainable society in close cooperation with local community and government.
- 4. We will establish an Eco-Campus through continual improvement, environmental load reduction, and pollution prevention.
- 5. We will set and undertake an annual review of environmental objectives and targets, including Mottainai (energy saving, resource saving, and recycling) and safety management of chemical substances.
- 6. The faculty will adhere to the legal requirements applicable to environmental issues in all the activities in the campus, and other environmental requirements to which the Environmental Management System (EMS) consents. We will promote voluntary environmental conversation and improvement activities.
