- (4) Field visits to;
 - the agricultural farms (high land vegetable cultivation),
 - an advanced Agricultural Cooperative (J.A.),
 - SMEs of agro-industry such as brewery/winery (rice wine (sake), grape/ apple wine, whisky) at Ina city, or sprout products
