Faculty of Arts at Shinshu University is seeking a native German or French speaker (or equivalent level) for a faculty position (3 years) for teaching German/French/English as a foreign language to undergraduates, commencing on April 1, 2026.

7. Work Content and Assigned Course (Responsibilities)

You will be responsible for conducting research on international exchange and foreign language education, and teaching courses such as Trends in European Culture, German and/or French Oral Communication (CEFR levels A2 - B1), and English Oral Communication (CEFR levels A2 - B2). These courses are to be conducted in English, German, or French as a medium of instruction with a textbook for communicative activities. Your teaching load will consist of three or four classes (total 6 or 8 hours) per week.

Additional responsibilities include:

- Advising and supporting students interested in studying abroad
- Assisting the International Exchange Committee

However, participation in faculty meetings and other university administrative duties is not required.
