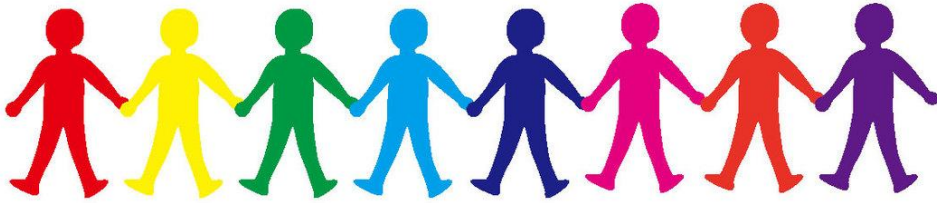

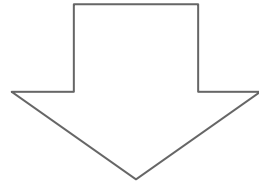

In China, they didn't want to spread it either.

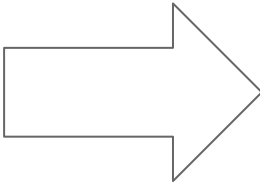
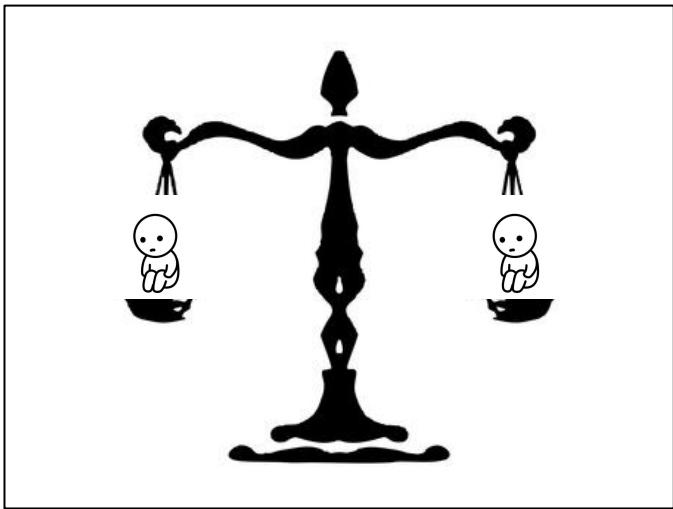


However, it's lonely to admit discrimination remains an issue in today's world.
