1. Outline

4. Job Responsibilities

Responsibilities include administrative, teaching, and student support work related to globalization as below:

 - 2. Supporting English language proficiency development for "Basics of English," in collaboration with its main instructors.
 - 3. Teaching topics related international exchange in schools in "Introduction to Community Education I"
 - 4. Other.
