General Education

Students take classes in academic literacy, liberal arts, English, etc., to acquire a wide range of knowledge.

Specialized Subjects

Students begin taking subjects required for the teacher's license, such as Basic (Fundamental) Subject Contents of Japanese Language in Elementary School, Introduction of Teaching Methods of Elementary School Mathematics, and Introduction of Pedagogical Theories. Each of the 14 training courses also offers specialized content classes.
