

Fare for transportation from Tokyo-Narita airport to Nagano

We can use two routes of JR-East and Keisei lines.

JR-East line: Nagano—(Hokuriku Shinkansen) -Tokyo—(Narita express)—Narita
1300 Yen + 1700 Yen
Ticket Express

Keisei 京成 line: Nagano—(Hokuriku Shinkansen) -Tokyo
----(JR Yamate-line)--Nippori (日暮里) --Keisei Skyliner---Narita
<200 Yen 1260 Yen + 1300 Yen
Ticket Ticket Express

Keisei-route needs change at Nippori from Keisei-line to JR-East line, but Keisei-route has more services and then your waiting time is shorter.

JR-East route is simple. You need to change at Tokyo station, but the Tokyo-Narita service is not enough (every 30 min service)

Tokyo ---Nagano(長野)

Hokuriku Shinkansen (北陸新幹線) is convenient. Every 15-20 min services.

Kagayaki(かがやき) Shinkansen: All seats are reserved 80 min

(8340 Yen: Ticket 4070 Yen, Express + reserve 4270 Yen)

Hakutaka (はくたか) 95 min 7810 Yen for non-reserved seat
Reserved seat (+ 500 Yen)

Asama(あさま) 105 min 7810 Yen for non-reserved seat
Reserved seat (+500 Yen)

Green car: + 4200 Yen.

Haneda-Airport is an in-city airport.

You need to use Haneda--- (monorail) ---Hamamatsu-chou----Tokyo route
< 1 h < 1000 Yen Every 5 min services

This may be the most convenient. I use this route, but this route is too busy
