

Announcement for an Open Faculty Position  
(Application deadline: August 6, 2026)

1. Outline:

Shinshu University invites applications for an Assistant Professor position in physics at Institute of Science, Academic Assembly.

2. Position and number of openings:

One tenure-track assistant professor position.

3. Position affiliation:

Institute of Science, Academic Assembly, Shinshu University

4. Department in charge:

Physics Course, Department of Science, Faculty of Science, Shinshu University, Asahi 3-1-1, Matsumoto City, Nagano Prefecture

5. Research field:

Experimental research in fields related to cosmic ray physics or high energy physics

6. Content of work:

(1) Publish research results in major journals of the discipline, and conduct other activities appropriate to the discipline.

(2) Teach in physics classes at the graduate and undergraduate levels.

(3) Supervise undergraduate, M.S., and Ph.D. students.

(4) Administrative and service works for the Course, Faculty, and University.

\*Faculties are expected to play active roles in obtaining external funds, communal activity, and international research activity.

7. Requirements:

(1) Qualifying candidates must have a doctorate degree in physics or neighboring field or should be expected to obtain the degree by April 1, 2027.

(2) Applicants must have excellent research achievements in the field described above.

(3) Strong motivation for education, research and other works related to the management of the Faculty of Science.

(4) Excellent oral and written Japanese language are required for teaching undergraduate students and research activities.

(5) Applicants is required to conduct research, education, and university administration in collaboration with relevant faculty members.

8. Start of Employment:

April 1, 2027

9. Period of employment

Five years as a tenure-track faculty member

10. Tenure-track institution

It is a system under which young researchers can apply for tenure after engaging in academic research and educational activities for a certain period. Candidates will be granted tenure if they are approved to have accrued high qualifications and academic abilities. A successful candidate hired through this recruitment program will be evaluated in the first half of the fifth year. After successfully passing the evaluation, he or she will be hired as a tenured faculty member from the sixth year onward. The evaluation will be based on the individual's achievements in research, education, and administrative activities.

12. Documents to be submitted:

- (1) Curriculum Vitae (with a portrait photo attached. Please state whether you have any record of awards or disciplinary measures.)
- (2) List of academic achievement (categorized into peer-reviewed journal papers, other papers or reviews, books, patents, prizes etc. marked for papers contributed as a main author)
- (3) A copy of 5 major publications
- (4) Summary of research achievements and future plans (A4-size, up to three pages)
- (5) Statement of teaching (A4-size, one page each)
- (6) A list of external funding
- (7) Full names and contact details including E-mail addresses of two references.

\*All documents and personal information submitted will be used for the sole purpose of candidate selection. On completion of the selection they will be handled properly under the rules of PIPL.

13. Deadline:

Application must be received by close of business on August 6, 2026.

14. Selection process:

After the first round of screening (document screening), the second round of screening (interview screening: including a presentation on education and research) will be conducted for those who pass the first round. Depending on the situation, either face-to-face or remote interviews will be conducted (travel and accommodation expenses for the interview will be borne by the applicant).
