10. Tenure-track institution

It is a system under which young researchers can apply for tenure after engaging in academic research and educational activities for a certain period. Candidates will be granted tenure if they are approved to have accrued high qualifications and academic abilities. A successful candidate hired through this recruitment program will be evaluated in the first half of the fifth year. After successfully passing the evaluation, he or she will be hired as a tenured faculty member from the sixth year onward. The evaluation will be based on the individual's achievements in research, education, and administrative activities.

 - (2) List of academic achievement (categorized into journal articles, conference proceedings (refereed or not refereed), books, review articles, etc.)

- (6) Statement of teaching (A4-size, one page)
