1. Written exam (in English) @Seminar Room AB (9th floor) 10:00-12:00

※You can enter the exam room from 9:15. Please be in the room by 9:40.

2. Interview @Seminar Room C (9th floor) 13:00-

※You can use Seminar Room AB for the waiting room.

The time schedule of the interview for each applicant will be on the notice board in front of the exam room. Please check it carefully and wait in the waiting room (staff will call you when your turn comes).

### 【Notice】

- (1) Bring your admission ticket for the examination (you have to download it and print it out).
- (2) A non-electronic translation dictionary (including medical dictionary) is permitted for the foreign language written exam
- (3) Due to the spread of infections such as Covid-19, we may ask you to wear a mask.  
Please bring it with you and follow the instructions.

### ●Type B (offsite)

- Examination date: Fri, January 5th, 2024

1. English

Submit your certificate of TOEFL iBT or IELTS (Academic Module) or TOEIC (L&R) to the admissions office by Fri, January 5th, 2024. Please see the Application Guidelines for details.

2. Interview

Applicants are required to take online interview by Zoom instead of taking it at Shinshu University.

(1) Date and Time

Fri, January 5th, 2024 (after 1:00 P.M.)

The interview time and details are to be notified to each applicant by email.

(2) Interview Room

Each examinee is required to prepare a room that satisfies all of the below requirements (Not the public places, internet cafe etc.).

- ① A quiet private room that people other than the examinee won't come in.
- ② A good network environment throughout the interview.
- ③ The examinee must be able to contact by phone or email with the examiner in case of emergency.

(3) Preparation in Advance

- ① Each examinee has responsibility to prepare the capable devices for the use of online interview and good network environment.
- ② The examinee will be interviewed using Zoom. Prepare the device that is capable for video call (e.g. PC with camera, tablet or smartphone) and install the latest Zoom in advance (<https://zoom.us/download>) .
- ③ The connection test will be done under the same environment prior to the interview. Please stand by 5 minutes before the specified date and time after you have set the necessary devices. The test will take 10 minutes.
- ④ Things you need during the interview
  - Admission Ticket
  - Devices for the online interview (PC for video call, phone for emergency contact etc.)

(4) Notes on the interview date

- ① Click the URL and enter the Zoom 5 minutes prior to the interview for the final connection test.
- ② If you are late for the interview, the examiners will wait for 20 minutes only. No further delays are allowed.
- ③ The schedule could be changed according to the other examinees' interview.
- ④ No visitor in the room during the interview.
- ⑤ The examiners will check that there is no injustice and visitor in the room by the web camera.
- ⑥ Recording the interview is prohibited. It is regarded as an injustice.
- ⑦ Prepare some device like mobile phone other than PC or tablet you use for the interview so that we can communicate in case of emergency like network trouble.
