O Characteristics and history

Shinshu University was founded in May, 1949. The University consists of eight faculties (Arts, Education Economics and Law, Science, Medicine, Engineering, Agriculture, Textile Science and Technology) scattered over five campuses. All the faculties have attached graduate schools. Shinshu University Video and Data Network Systems connect the five campuses with each other. By using the systems, intercampus classes can be held. For example, the Graduate School of Education has two courses and six attached schools for teacher training and research. Also it has the Center for Research on Innovative Learning and the Institute of Nature Education in Shiga Heights and provides characteristic studies. The school aims to educate students so that they will be able to deal with the growing educational problems of modern society which has changed greatly in recent years. Nagano prefecture is famous for being an advanced prefecture in education and is a leader in promoting education in Japan. Our school plays an important role in Nagano prefectural education.

①Japanese language basic course

Center for Global Education provides 16-week Japanese language basic courses at 3 levels from beginners to intermediate. The courses aim at developing basic communication skills in Japanese in beginners classes, and at advancing Japanese language ability in upper classes.

2) Japanese language supplementary course

Japanese language supplementary courses are offered in all the campuses and students of the Teacher Training Program can attend the courses to improve their Japanese.

Academic advisor supervises research depending on students' interest. No classes are provided in English.

In principle, applicants for this course are required to hold a master's degree or a professional degree and will be accepted as a research student. We do not permit the official credit. They are provided with opportunities to get in contact with other international and Japanese students.

We make a field trip to some places worth visiting once a year.

We keep in touch with each other. In the case of a Lithuanian student, she made a friendly visit to Japan with her six students and the principal of her school in May, 2012. They interacted closely with students of Faculty of Education, Shinshu University.
